



10 EASY WAYS TO AVOID PARKING CITATIONS

1

Your license plate is your parking permit. Register your license plate at parking.ucf.edu.



2

Obey all signs, pavement markings, and barricades in all lots and garages, especially ones that allow multiple permits.



3

Do not use accessible parking spaces if you do not have an accessible hangtag.

4

Do not park on the grass or sidewalk.

5

Do not park in reserved or numbered parking spaces unless it's your space. And do not block or park in service vehicle spaces.

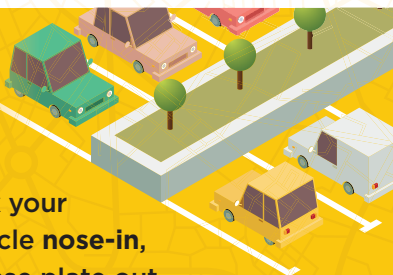

Park your vehicle **nose-in**, license plate out.

ParkMobile

Download the ParkMobile app or scan QR code posted at the metered space to pay for parking --even if you have a parking permit. Spaces are enforced 24/7.

Use the Pegasus Express shuttles to get around campus.

Arrive early. Give yourself plenty of time to find an appropriate parking space.

10

If you receive a parking citation, be prompt with your response to avoid late fees, immobilization or towing.



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
